

<h1>Threats to Subsistence</h1>	<p>A threat to animal or plant life that may affect growing or hunting and, in effect, affect the way of life for local humans.</p>	
<h1>Tsunami</h1>	<p>A large sea-wave produced by a sub-marine earthquake or volcanic eruption.</p>	
<h1>Blizzard</h1>	<p>A storm with dry, driving snow, strong winds, and intense cold.</p>	
<h1>Tundra Fire</h1>	<p>A wildfire started on the tundra, where carbon released through the warming of the ground catches on fire.</p>	
<h1>Ice Shove</h1>	<p>(Ivu) A surge of ice from an ocean or lake onto the shore. They are caused by ocean currents, strong winds, or temperature differences pushing ice.</p>	
<h1>Storm Surge</h1>	<p>A rising of the sea as a result of atmospheric pressure changes and wind associated with a storm.</p>	
	<p>A prolonged period of abnormally low rainfall;</p>

# Wild Fire

A large, destructive fire that spreads quickly over woodlands or brush



# Flood

An overflowing of a large amount of water beyond its normal confines, especially over dry land.



# Hurricane

A storm with a violent wind, in particular a tropical cyclone in the Caribbean.



# Tornado

A mobile, destructive vortex of violently rotating winds having the appearance of a funnel-shaped cloud.



# Earthquake

A sudden and violent shaking of the ground, sometimes causing great destruction as a result of movements within the Earth's or volcanic action.
